### **Scholarship Guidelines**

The Walter C. Robinson (WCR) Scholarship is in memory of a man who was an advocate of higher education, and was always willing to assist those pursuing a college degree by giving what he could to assist with their educational needs. Charles graduated from Tucker High School in DeKalb County. After graduating high school, he attended DeKalb College for two years until being called to active duty. He was active in his church and civic activities as well. He committed his time working as a truck driver to ensure that his daughters were able to attend college.

The *Purpose* of the *WCR Scholarship* is to provide scholarships to deserving high school graduating seniors pursuing undergraduate study at either a two-year or four-year post-secondary institution.

WCR Family Foundation will award one scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 to an eligible applicant from either Big Miller Grove Baptist Church or Springfield Baptist Church. <u>NOTE: All award decisions are contingent on the</u> <u>Board's receipt of final documentation of enrollment. The recipient must provide proof of graduation via a final</u> <u>transcript of graduation and evidence of registration in an accredited higher education or vocational institution.</u> <u>Enrollment must commence by Spring Semester 2022 or its academic equivalent.</u> The scholarship will be credited directly to the institution in which the student is enrolled to cover tuition, fees and related educational expenses.

#### Criteria and eligibility

- 1. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
- 2. Applicant must be a Georgia resident.
- 3. Applicant must be an individual seeking enrollment at either a two-year or four-year educational institution.
- 4. Applicant must be a member of Big Miller Grove Baptist Church (BMG) or Springfield Baptist Church (SBC).
- 5. Applicant must be able to demonstrate community involvement through volunteer work inside and outside of their respective church.

#### **General Instructions**

- 1. Refer to the application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e. references, evidence of GPA, etc.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 2. If any question does not apply to you in this application, please put N/A in the space.
- 3. Type and print legibly. Illegible applications will not be considered.

#### **Application Process:**

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
- 2. Two (2) letters of recommendations: one (1) from your choice of high school teachers, administrators, counselors, employers, or an individual with significant knowledge of applicant's volunteer work in the community and one (1) from a BMG or SBC auxiliary leader in an auxiliary that you actively participate in.
- 3. An official and recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average.
- 4. Personal Essay (500-750 words). Refer to the application for the essay topic. The essay shall contain no grammatical errors.

Deadline: ALL applications must be postmarked by May 7, 2021 (no exceptions).
