

# 2021 Lucas Woods Jr. Scholarship

The Springfield Baptist Church has been generously endowed by the family of the late Lucas Woods, Jr. – the first Children's Pastor of Springfield Baptist Church. He dedicated his life to building and teaching children about the Kingdom of God. He was deeply passionate about developing "Kingdom Kids" and was creative in his teachings to instill in every child a firm foundation of the love of Jesus Christ. The Woods Scholarship provides financial scholarships to a deserving graduating high school seniors intending to pursue post-high school course of study at an accredited college/university or other post-secondary educational institution.

#### **Award Amount**

A \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded up to (4) high school seniors.

### **Application Deadline & Information**

The Application Deadline is **April 16, 2021**.

- Only completed scholarship entries will be accepted. No late entries will be accepted.
- Scholarship awards will be disbursed after July 1, 2021. Each award recipient will receive
  instructions on disbursement procedures and guidelines. Disbursement of scholarship
  funds is contingent upon enrollment.

# Requirements

- 1. Applicant must be a member of the Springfield Baptist Church, for at least six (6) months.
- 2. Applicant must be a high school graduating senior.
- 3. The student must have a current cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Transcript: Submit a current grade report that indicates current GPA or Transcript.
- 5. **Photo headshot**: A black and white or color photo of applicant is required. (head shot or full body).
- 6. Applicant must demonstrate positive impact and involvement in school, church and the



Community.

- 7. Applicant must be accepted at and attend an accredited 2- or 4-year college/university.
- 8. Application must include a **letter of recommendation** from a teacher, counselor, employer, ministry leader, community member, coach, club sponsor or individual with significant knowledge of applicant's character, experience, and involvement.
- 9. Applicant must be a citizen of the United States.
- 10. Submit an essay using 500 words or less to explain how your church ministry has impacted your life and why you should be a recipient of this scholarship. If at any time you were Kingdom Kid, please describe your experience, lessons learned, etc.
- 11. Submit a Student Resume: It should include a brief description of the following:
  - a. a list of academic awards and recognition, and
  - b. a list of extracurricular activities, including church-related activities.
